General Safety Instructions

- •Complete pre-start checklist
- Read Manufacturers Operation Manual .
- •Report any faults or damage :
- •Do not wear loose clothing or jeweilery
- •Do not operate equipment near pedestrians or people
- •Do not operate without the appropriate PPE as detailed
- •Do not operate equipment under the influence of drugs or alcohol

General Engine Safety

- •Refuelling Do not smoke, or introduce ignition source, always turn engine off and allow engine to cool first, relieve fuel pressure by loosening cap slowly, wipe clean any fuel spills prior to re-start, If fuel spilled on clothes change clothes, ensure cap is replaced & store fuel vessel away from work area
- Do not breathe fuel vapour& replace cap securely after fuelling
- Do not operate engine without adequate ventilation
- ·Beware of hot surfaces on engine & other parts

☐ Traffic & moving machinery ☐ Stored energy – air, hydraulic, electricity, pressure

General Electricity Safety

•Assess the immediate work area for any hazards

•Hazards to check for that may require risk control-

Control or eliminate all the risks associated with the hazards

- •Ensure all electrical equipment has a current test tag within 3 months
- •Do not operate equipment in or around water or damp environments
- •It is recommended to use a safety switch to power this equipment
- Ensure the power lead is well stowed and do not present trip hazards elsolate the power by removing the plug prior to performing any work on the equipment including prior to changing leads or tools or bits
- Always uncoil power leads prior to use

Operating Safety Instructions

Plan the work to be done

Ensure operators of EWP's with a platform height of 11m or greater Always perform the pre-start functions in the EWP Log Book and hold a WP - National Licence to Perform High Risk Class WP. For all ensure that the safety release is operable from the gr other EWP's it is recommended to have a Yellow card or similar competence training Ensure the EWP has a log book on hand and check that it is in service and has no current service faults. Never use if the EWP has a fault

Check overhead hazards including powerlines and maintain minimum approach distances from all powerlines - see manual

Check the ground where the EWP will be operated to ensure it is firm dry and free from obstructions and holes. Electric scissors should operate on sealed surfaces

Use barricades to restrict pedestrian and traffic flow near the EWP

Do not tie the EWP platform to an adjacent platform or structure

Do not use the EWP lift as a lifting aid, crane or lifting or device. Do not use the boom to push or pull objects Do not allow anyone to tamper with the machine from the ground

Check the SWL (Safe Working Load) of the EWP and ensure the weight to be placed in the basket including the personnel is under whilst in use unless under emergency conditions Ensure all gates on the basket remain closed at all times unless

the SWL Do not drive with the platform elevated on sloping or uneven ground above 4 degrees and avoid driving on lesser slopes

entering and exiting the basket from the ground

Check the load limit of bridges and ramps before driving on them

Keep both feet or all persons in the basket firmly on floor at all times. Do not stand on ladders, boxes or the basket Do not use the machine as a ground for welding

If the boom is in a position with one or more wheels off the ground, remove all personnel before attempting to stabilize

Do not operate the machine in wind conditions or with wind gusts

Use spotters and look out personnel when vision is obscured

equal or greater than 40KMPH Stow EWP, lower and park on flat level ground and shut down all

Never use anything other than operators foot to engage the safety

power before leaving EWP. Travel grades in slow speed only and beware of stopping distances in

all speeds, switch to slow speed before stopping

If EWP is on a trailer, ensure trailer is attached to vehicle when loading and unloading

Refer to manual for towing instructions

Refer to manual for lifting instructions but never lift with only 2 chains or slings.
